THE BIBLE

Joshua and Caleb in the Promised Land: Numbers 13:2-14:9;
(Matthew 6:25-34)

QUESTIONS

- Why were the twelve spies sent to Canaan before the Israelites?
- Why was Caleb and Joshua's report so different from the other spies' reports?
- Whose reports honored God?
- Read Matthew 6:34. What does this verse mean to you?
- What is one worry you can trust God with?
- Can you think of a time you trusted God with a difficult thing in your life?
- What can help you remember to trust God?

ACTIVITY

Give each kid a sheet of white paper and ask them to write, "I can trust God" by dipping a paintbrush in a half baking soda/half water mixture. Tell the kids to paint over the entire surface of the paper with grape juice concentrate to reveal the Big Idea!
